COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA

- 1. N.J.S. 14A:5-28 Books and Records (rights of inspection) Consideration of a Draft Final Report.
- 2. <u>General Repealer</u> Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report identifying anachronistic provisions in the law and recommending their repeal.
- 3. <u>Title 39-Driving While Intoxicated</u>— Consideration of a Memorandum and a chart summarizing certain aspects of the laws of all 50 States for purposes of comparison.
- 4. <u>Code of Criminal Justice: Physical Force in Addition to Sexual Contact</u> Consideration of a new project to clarify the Criminal Code section relating to physical force in addition to sexual contact.
