- 1. <u>Uniform Common Interest Ownership Act</u> –Further consideration of a Draft Tentative Report containing the first two Articles of the UCIOA with modifications from the Uniform Act to reflect New Jersey law and the determinations made by the Commission at this time.
- 2. <u>New Jersey Electronic Legal Material Act</u> Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report relating to the Uniform Electronic Legal Materials Act and the authentication, security and preservation of New Jersey's legal materials.

- 5. <u>Uniform Probate Code</u> Consideration of a Memorandum updating the Commission on preliminary research regarding the Uniform Probate Code (UPC), and a request for authorization to conduct further research and analysis, and to engage in outreach for comment on this project, with a view to possible recommendation of all or part of the latest version of the UPC for adoption in New Jersey.
