

- Meaning of "Physical Examination" Consideration of a Draft Final Report proposing a statutory definition for the term "physical examination" for purposes of New Jersey's Tort Claims Act (N.J.S. 59:6-4). Report
- Clarification of Tenure Consideration of a Draft Final Report recommending modifications to N.J.S. 18A:17-2, to clarify tenure provisions for certain school employees. <u>Report</u>
