- 1. <u>"Residence" for Purposes of Sex Offender Registration</u> Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report regarding proposed modification of N.J.S. 2C:7-2 to deal with the registration of secondary addresses in response to *State v. Halloran,* 446 N.J. Super. 381 (Law Div. 2014) that incorporates additional research and proposed statutory language as directed by the Commission.
- 2. <u>Suspended License</u> Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report proposing modifications of the language of N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b) to clarify that an individual who operates a motor vehicle beyond the determinate sentence term of suspension, but before reinstatement, should not be charged with a violation of the criminal law.
- 3. <u>Public Assistance Law</u> Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report regarding Public Assistance that represents a revision of the Commission's 2009 Final Report on this subject.

- 7. Open Public Records Act Security Camera Footage Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to address the issues reviewed by the New Jersey Supreme Court in *Gilleran v. Township of Bloomfield*, 227 N.J. 159 (2016).
