Recreational or Social Activities -** Consideration of a Draft Final Report recommending modifications to N.J.S. 34:15-7 to clarify the scope of the "recreational or social activities" defense, as discussed in *Goulding v. N.J. Friendship House, Inc.*, 245 N.J. 157 (2021), and *Lozano v. Frank DeLuca Constr.*, 178 N.J. 513 (2004). Report
- 2. "Misrepresentation of a Material Fact" in the NJ Gross Income Tax Act Consideration of a Draft Final Report proposing the modification of New Jersey's statute concerning limitations on tax assessment, N.J.S. 54A:9-4, to eliminate the apparent conflict between the two fraud exceptions subsections (c)(1) and (c)(4) and the use of the word "misrepresentation," as discussed in *Malhotra v. Director, Division of Taxation*, 32 N.J. Tax 443 (2021). Report
- **3. Uniform Commercial Code 2022 Amendments** Consideration of a Draft Final Report recommending enactment of the 2022 Amendments to the Uniform Commercial Code. Updated Report
- **4.** Merger of Criminal Convictions for Leaving-the-Scene and Endangering an Injured Victim Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to address the merger of criminal convictions pursuant to N.J.S. 2C:1-8, N.J.S. 2C:11-5.1, and N.J.S. 2C:12-1.2, as discussed in State v. Herrera, 469 N.J. Super. 559 (App. Div. 2022). Memo
- **5. Joint Motions to Vacate Parole Ineligibility -** Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to clarify the statute concerning joint motions to vacate parole ineligibility, N.J.S. 2C:35-12, as discussed in *State v. Arroyo-Nunez*, 470 N.J. Super. 351 (App. Div. 2022). Memo
