

1. Juvenile Sex Offender Lifetime Registration – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report proposing modifications to N.J.S. 2C:7-2 clarifying that lifetime registration and notification obligations are unconstitutional as applied to juvenile sex offenders, as held by the New Jersey Supreme Court in *State in Interest of C.K.*, 233 N.J. 44, 77 (2018). Report

2. Retroactive Modification of Child Support Obligations – Consideration of an Update Memorandum summarizing commenter feedback on proposed modifications to N.J.S. 2A:17-56.23a intended to clarify that adult adoption and emancipation are not subject to the statutory prohibition on retroactive modification of child support obligations. <u>Memo</u>

3. Public Safety – Operating an unmanned aircraft system while under the influence -Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to evaluate the inclusion of an informed consent provision within New Jersey's Act Concerning Unmanned Aircraft Systems, specifically, N.J.S. 2C:40-8(e). <u>Memo</u>

4. Affidavit of Merit Statute – "Licensed Practical Nurse" - Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to address whether the Affidavit of Merit Statute under N.J.S. 2A:53A-26 would benefit from modification to address that Licensed Practical Nurses are not "licensed persons" for purposes of the statute, consistent with the decision in *Gilligan v. Junod*, 474 N.J. Super. 39, 43-44 (App. Div. 2022), leave to appeal denied, 253 N.J. 273 (2023). <u>Memo</u>

5. Driving While Intoxicated – Contributions to the Drunk Driving Enforcement Fund for Refusal to Submit to Chemical Tests - Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to address the intersection of N.J.S. 39:4-50.8 and N.J.S. 39:4-50.2(e) as they concern the refusal to submit to a test for the presence of alcohol. <u>Memo</u>
