COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA

1. Suspended License – Consideration of a Revised Draft Final Report recommending statutory modifications to clarify that an individual who operates a motor vehicle beyond the determinate sentenced term of suspension, but before reinstatement of their driving privileges by the Motor Vehicle Commission, may properly be charged with N.J.S. 39:3-10 and not N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b).
2. Misdemeanor – Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report proposing statutory modifications to eliminate unnecessary references to the term “misdemeanor” in the New Jersey statutes – a detailed Appendix identifying the proposed changes is also included.
3. Unclaimed Property – Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report proposing modifications to New Jersey’s statutes concerning unclaimed property in response to comments received regarding the Revised Uniform Unclaimed Property Act.
4. Meaning of “Material” in N.J.S. 2C:21-4.6 (*State v. Goodwin*) – Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report to clarify the meaning of the term “material” in the insurance fraud statute (N.J.S. 2C:21-4.6) pursuant to the determination of the New Jersey Supreme Court in *State v. Goodwin*, 224 N.J. 102 (2016)
5. Meaning of “Harassment” in N.J.S. 2C:33-4 subsec. (c) (*State v. Burkert*) – Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to clarify N.J.S. 2C:33-4 subsection (c) pursuant to the decision of the New Jersey Supreme Court in *State v. Burkert*, 231 N.J. 257 (2017).
6. Uniform Powers of Appointment Act (UPAA) – Consideration of a Memorandum updating the Commission regarding the status of the preliminary work done regarding this Act and seeking guidance regarding Staff’s plan to move forward.
