- **1.** Unemployment Benefits for Individuals Wrongly Incarcerated Consideration of a Revised Draft Final Report proposing modifications to N.J.S. 43:21-5 in response to the decision in *Haley v. Board of Review, Department of Labor*, 245 N.J. 511 (2021), to clarify the way incarceration should be treated for purposes of unemployment benefits and including a rebuttable presumption. Report
- **2. Eminent Domain Action Interest Rates –** Consideration of a Draft Final Report recommending modifications to N.J.S. 20:3-32, N.J.S. 27:7-22, and other eminent domain statutes to eliminate fixed interest rate provisions repealed by the Eminent Domain Act, as held in *State by Commissioner of Transportation v. St. Mary's Church Gloucester*, 464 N.J. Super. 579 (App. Div. 2020). Report
- **3. Megan's Law and the Definition of "Minor" –** Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report recommending the modification of N.J.S. 2C:7-2 to clarify that the term "minor" as used in the Act refers to persons under the age of eighteen years of age consistent with *State v. Farkas*, 2022 WL 803466 (App. Div. 2022). Report
- **4.** Tort Claims Act: Applicability of Notice Provision to Contribution and Indemnification Claims Consideration of an Update Memorandum addressing whether the notice of claim provision in N.J.S. 59:8-8 applies to third-party and crossclaims for contribution and indemnification, as discussed in *Jones v. Morey's Pier, Inc.*, 230 N.J. 142 (2017). Memo
- **5. Prison and Youth Correctional Facilities –** Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a project to consider the continuing viability of the terms "farms," "camps," and "quarries" in N.J.S. 30:4-136 and N.J.S. 30:4-146. Memo
