- Uniform Recognition and Enforcement of Canadian Domestic Violence Protection Orders Act - Consideration of a Revised Draft Tentative Report proposing modifications to New Jersey statutes to permit recognition of Canadian domestic violence protection orders through incorporation of relevant provisions of the Uniform Act and comments received.
