Goodwin)</u>: Consideration of a Memorandum requesting a change to the Final Report that clarifies the meaning of the term "material" in the insurance fraud statute (N.J.S. 2C:21-4.6) pursuant to the determination of the New Jersey Supreme Court in *State v. Goodwin*, 224 N.J. 102 (2016). <u>Memo</u>

- 5. Meaning of Widow in N.J.S. 54:4–3.30: Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to define the term "widow" and "widower" in the context of N.J.S. 54:4–3.30 as discussed in *Pruent-Stevens v. Twp. of Toms River*, 30 N.J. Tax 200 (N.J. Tax 2017). Memo
- 6. <u>School Board Reclassification</u>: Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project to modify Title 18A:9-1 et seq. to clarify the effect of voided election results on future ballot initiatives as discussed in *City of Orange Twp. Bd. of Educ. v. City of Orange Twp.*, L-6652-17 (Ch. Div. 2017). <u>Memo</u>
- 7. <u>Mandatory Refund of Taxes Mistakenly Paid to a Municipality</u>: Consideration of a Memorandum proposing modification of N.J.S. 54:4-52 to reflect that a municipality must refund a taxpayer who mistakenly pays taxes on property not owned, subject to a three year statute of limitations, as discussed in <u>Hanover Floral Co. v. East Hanover Township</u>, 30 N.J. Tax 181 (N.J. Tax 2017). <u>Memo</u>
- 8. <u>Definition of "Under the Influence"</u>: Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project assigning a definition to the term "under the influence" in the New Jersey DWI statute as discussed in *State v. Siervo*, 2018 WL 266734 (App. Div. 2018). Memo
